
Dear Friends:

I write to you today to express my support of expanding reliable cell phone coverage to the Hyco Lake area of Person County, North Carolina. I live about two miles from this area and I pastor a United Methodist congregation very near Hyco Lake. A large number of my parishioners live on or near Hyco Lake as well. At the present time, placing a cell phone call in this area is extremely difficult if not impossible. My current carrier assures me that the relatively recent location of a tower by their company in Leasburg, NC should allow me to place calls with no problem but that is simply not the case. A carrier had planned a tower erection near us a few months ago but I understand those plans have been cancelled.

Cell phone coverage for me is critical. I visit my congregation and potential congregants often, taking me away from my office and reliable landline accessibility. My cell phone is my primary source of communication with others and frankly, at the present time, it is so unreliable that I hesitate to ask people to try and reach me on it. If a carrier would place a tower near me and offer affordable, reliable service I would be their customer in an instant! It would be incredibly helpful to me in my ministry.

Should your company consider erecting a tower nearby I can promise you there would be many people interested in switching, if necessary, to your company to receive improved service.
